

How to Install Adobe Reader

Problems with the eBook

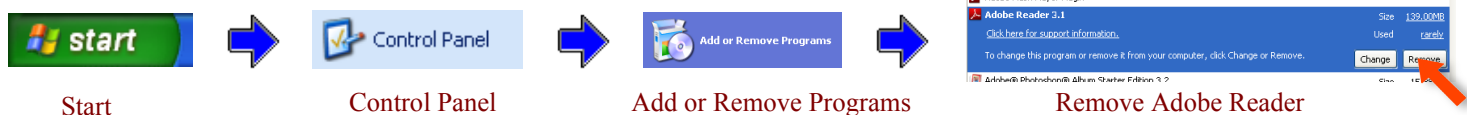
One source of problems with the eBook is an out-of-date or corrupt version of Adobe Reader, even though it works with normal PDF files. The answer is to uninstall it, then install the latest version.

Initial Checks

You will need to be logged on with an account type of **Computer Administrator**. This is the default account, so if you are unsure about this you are probably OK.

You will also need to have a high speed connection to the Internet (**Broadband**).

Uninstall the current version of Adobe Reader

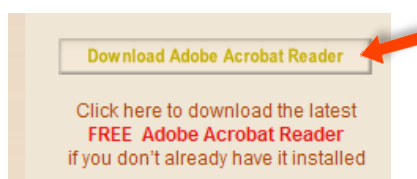


Select **Adobe Reader** and then click the **Remove** button. Follow the instructions given.

If you have an old version of **Adobe Acrobat**, or other versions of Adobe Reader, then remove these as well.

Restart your computer

Install the latest version of Adobe Reader



Click on **Download Adobe Reader** button in the right hand panel of the **Print Rules** page.

Follow the installation instructions then restart your computer if requested.

Accept the Licence Agreement

Run Adobe Reader and accept the licence agreement.



There will probably be an icon on your desktop. If there is, click on this.

If not, run Adobe Reader from **All Programs**.
